## Women's DV Court Assistance Service

Victim Support Services provide a *Women's DV Court Assistance* Service for women who are applying for, or already have an intervention order.

The aim is to support women within the courts to increase their access to the justice system.

#### The service provides:

- Work with women who wish to directly apply to the court for an intervention order,
- Legal advice on all aspects of applying for a new intervention order or intervention order variations and revocations,
  - Assisting women to complete forms and obtain evidence.
  - · Advocating for fee waiver, when appropriate.
    - Support women to report breaches,
  - Support women when a defendant breaches.
